- In order to offer the trees at reduced costs, the municipality **orders the trees in the Fall**, in co-operation with several area municipalities, for distribution to residents in the Spring.

SPECIES	SITE SUITABILITY & SOIL CONSIDERATIONS	SPECIES	SITE SUITABILITY & SOIL CONSIDERATIONS
PINE, WHITE	Fresh to moist, well – drained sands or sandy to clay loam soils. Avoid extremely dry or exposed sites and highly alkaline soils. Will tolerate some shade.	WHITE CEDAR	Will tolerate a wide range of soils (acidic to alkaline), moderately dry to very moist. Will tolerate some shade.
EASTERN HEMLOCK	Deep, moist and well drained soils. Tolerant of shade.	WALNUT, BLACK	Deep, fertile, moist loam soils. Require full sunlight.
SPRUCE, WHITE	Fresh to moist sands, sandy loams, clay loams or well drained clay soils. Avoid very dry or wet sites. Will tolerate some shade.	BIRCH, WHITE	Tolerable of most soils and moisture levels. Require full sunlight.
SPRUCE, NORWAY	Will tolerate a wide range of soil conditions. Avoid wet sites. Best in full sunlight.	OAK, RED	Fine, deep soils, loam or silt-loam porous, sandy or gravelly soils with good drainage. Full sun.
CHERRY, BLACK	Require full sunlight and moderately moist loam soils.	OAK, BUR	Slow growing. Tolerant of harsh conditions. Very long lived. Acorns are valued wildlife food.
DOGWOOD, RED OSIER	Species of swamps & low meadows, rich, moist soils. Tolerates flooding. Moderate to full sunlight	SUGAR MAPLE	Deep, moist sandy loam to clay loam soils. Avoid dry, wet, or exposed sites. Tolerant of shade, requires protection, tending and maintenance in open situations.
		SILVER MAPLE	Moist deep soils including silts or clays found along watercourses. Will tolerate some shade.
